

Do I Need A Bachelor's Degree to Apply for the Teachers of Tomorrow program?

YES. To apply for alternative teacher certification in North Carolina, you need to have a 4-year bachelor's degree and a 2.7+ overall GPA.

Does Teachers of Tomorrow Take Any Financial Aid?

Teachers of Tomorrow is not eligible for any federal financial aid. However, we provide annual scholarships and work with school districts to create financial opportunities to ease the transition into a teaching career.

We also offer flexible payment plans helping aspiring educators get access to high-quality teacher education.

Does Teachers of Tomorrow Offer Financial Assistance to Military Workers?

YES. North Carolina Teachers of Tomorrow supports military personnel, and veterans in pursuing a teaching career.

How Long Does it Take to Complete the ACP?

The alternative certification program is a self-paced online curriculum. This means finishing it depends on your availability and learning pace.
